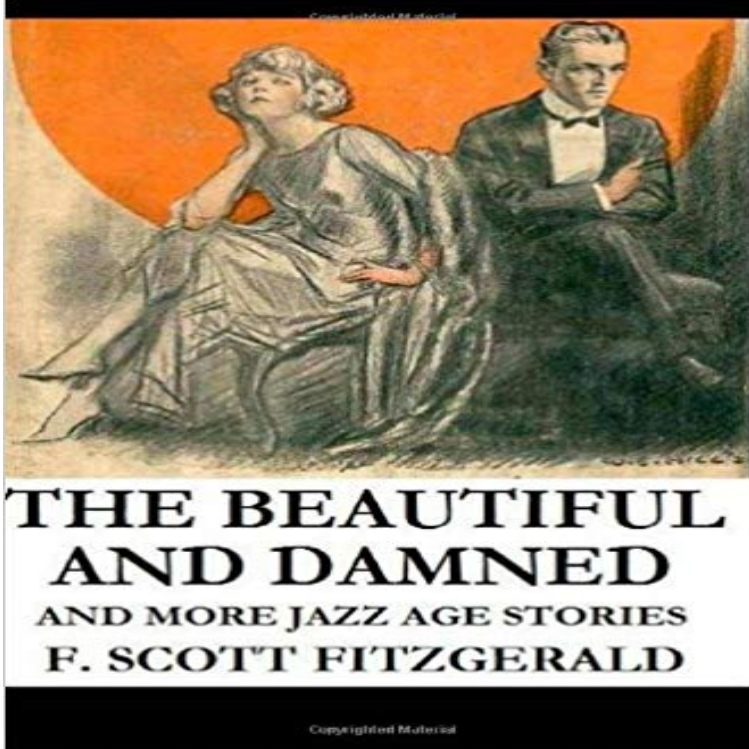


The Beautiful and Damned and More Jazz Age Stories



The Beautiful and Damned, first published by Scribners in 1922, is F. Scott Fitzgerald's second novel. It portrays the Eastern elite during the Jazz Age, exploring New York Cafe Society. As in Fitzgerald's other novels, the characters are complex, especially with respect to marriage and intimacy. The book is believed to be largely based on Fitzgerald's relationship with Zelda Fitzgerald. It tells the story of Anthony Patch, a 1910s socialite and presumptive heir to a tycoon's fortune, his relationship with his wife, Gloria, his service in the army, and his alcoholism. This volume also contains the classic Jazz Age short stories *Bernice Bobs Her Hair*, and *The Four Fists*.
