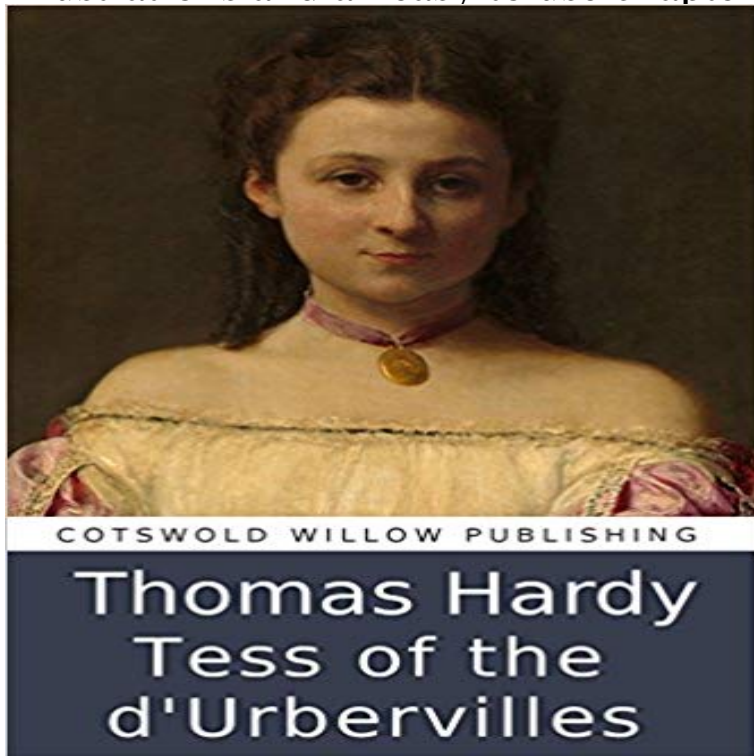


Tess of the D'Urbervilles (Illustrated): with a range of original illustrations and an easy to use chapter index.

She is honest, so ends up losing what she wants most in the world. And her final decision has a terrible, inevitable finality, given the morality of the time. Tess of the D'Urbervilles is possibly Hardy's most controversial novel. It is a gritty introduction to the darker side of society with an exploration of how double standards, illegitimate childbearing, rape and murder are handled in a highly moralistic society. Subtitled *A Pure Woman*, the reader is challenged to join Tess on life's journey and judge without piety, whether Tess is the sinner, or the sinned against.
