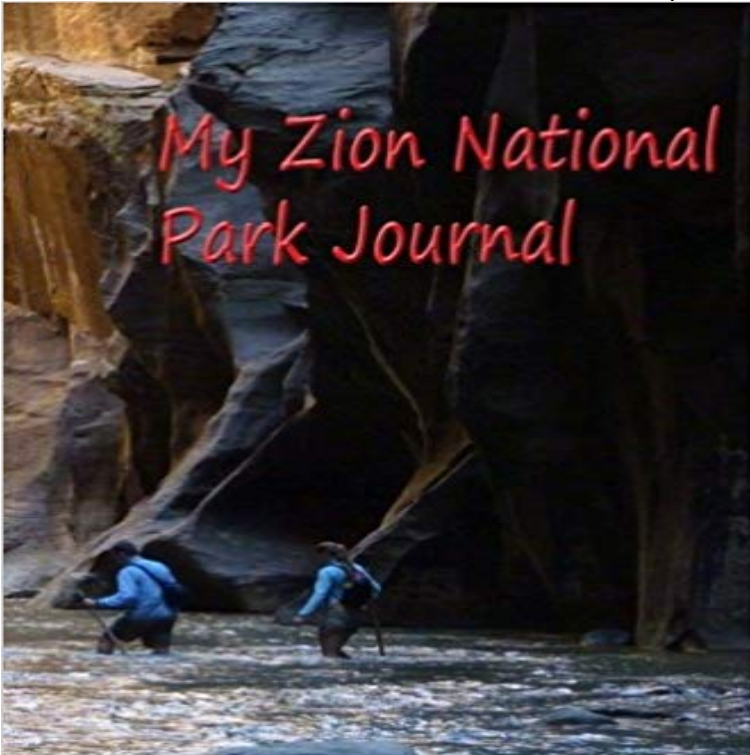


# My Zion National Park Journal: To Commemorate the Centennial of the National Park Service 1916-2016 (National Park Journals) (Volume 6)
