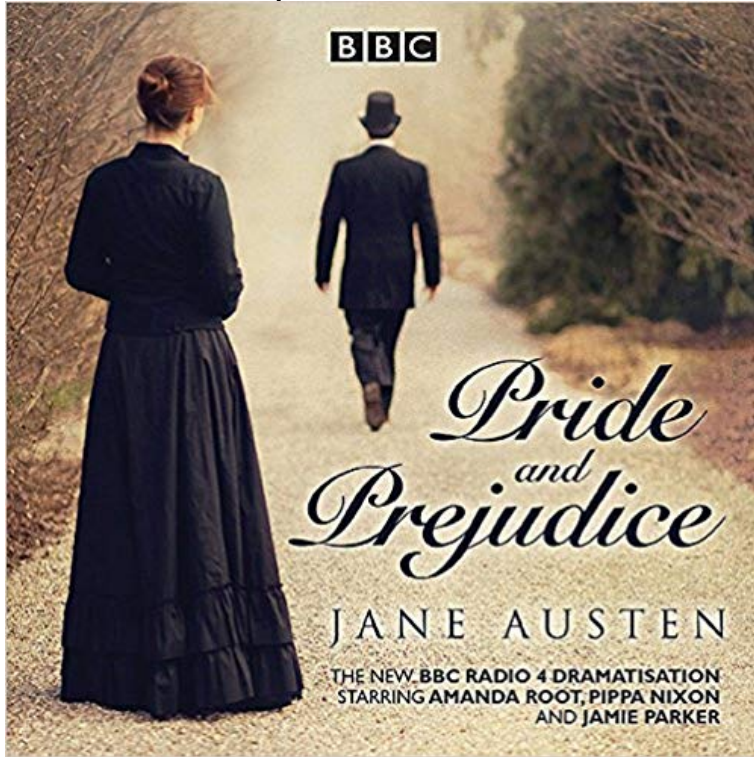


# Pride and Prejudice
