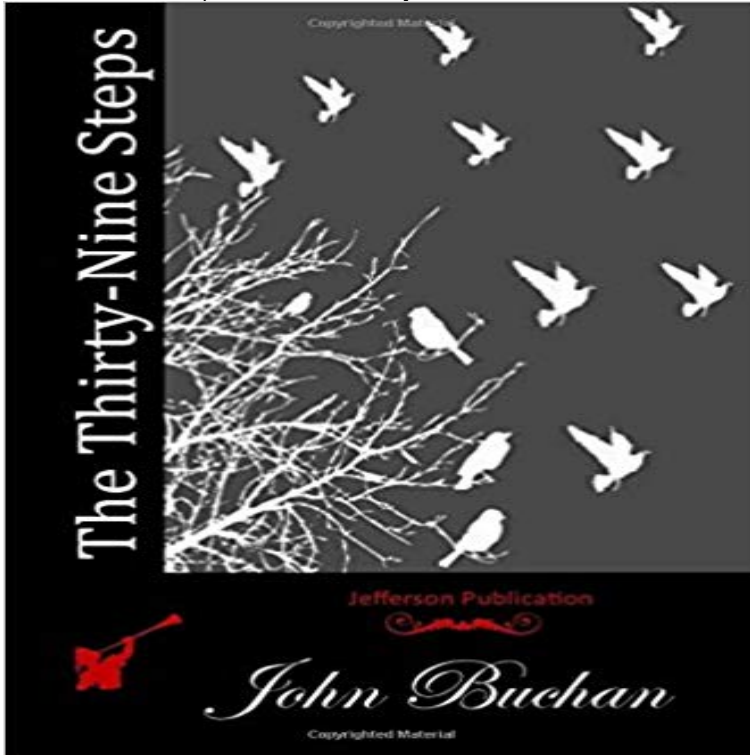


# The Thirty-Nine Steps
