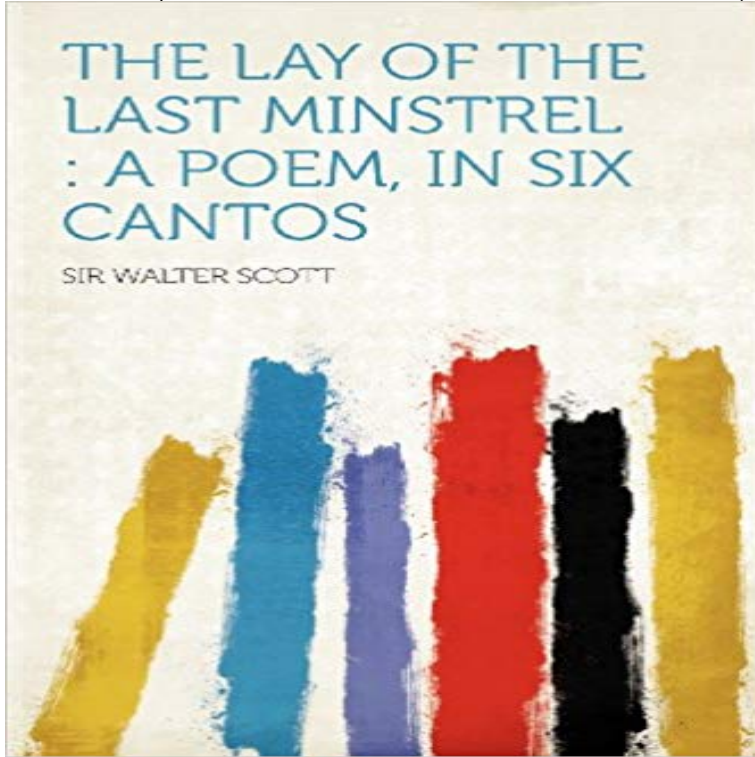


The Lay of the Last Minstrel: a Poem, in Six Cantos
